	2.	The information is a summary of the Tenant's rent payment record, including the amount of the Tenant's periodic rent payment;
	3.	The information is a copy of a material noncompliance notice that has not been remedied or, termination notice given to the Tenant under § <u>55-248.31</u> of the Virginia Residential Landlord Tenant Act and the Tenant did not remain in the Dwelling Unit thereafter;
	4.	The information is requested by a local, state, or federal law-enforcement or public safety official in the performance of the officer's duties;
	5.	The information is requested by a local commissioner of the revenue in accordance with § 58.1-390 of the Code of Virginia;
	6.	The information is otherwise provided in the case of an emergency;
	7.	The information is requested pursuant to a subpoena in a civil case;
	8.	The information is requested by a contract purchaser of the Landlord's property; provided the contract purchaser agrees in writing to maintain the confidentiality of such information;
	9.	The information is requested by a lender of the Landlord for financing or refinancing of the property, or in the event of any mortgage default, foreclosure, or similar event;
	10.	The third party is the Landlord's attorney; or
	11.	The information is requested by the commanding officer, military housing officer, or military attorney of the Tenant.
	12.	To the extent that it is a necessary for a third person to translate on behalf of Tenant to or from the English language, any information provided to such translator.
	13.	The information is requested by a property, condominium or similar association in which the Dwelling Unit is located.
